LAUNCHING OF CEB GREENFIELD RENEWABLE ENERGY SCHEME

In line with the National Budget Speech 2021-2022, the **Central Electricity Board (CEB)** is pleased to inform its customers and the general public of the launching of the **CEB Greenfield Renewable Energy Scheme**.

In the current phase of the Scheme, the CEB will consider applications from Public Sector Entities (Government departments, local authorities, statutory bodies, Government-owned entities, Government-controlled entities, and any entity designated by the Government). A total cumulative capacity of sixty (60) megawatts (MW) has been earmarked, with the maximum capacity of each project not exceeding fifteen (15) MW ac. Projects received in excess of the allocated 60 MW capacity will be placed on a waiting list.

Any Public Sector Entity engaging in a renewable energy project under this Scheme will operate as an Independent Power Producer (IPP). In this regard, all energy generated by the renewable energy facility shall be exported to the CEB grid. **A tariff of MUR 3.73 will be paid to the Public Sector Entity for each unit (kWh) of energy exported to the grid.**

Public Sector Entities wishing to participate in this Scheme are invited to submit a synopsis of their proposed renewable energy projects, of which a template can be downloaded from the CEB website at <http://ceb.mu> - The project synopsis, enclosed in a sealed envelope and marked "CEB GREENFIELD RE SCHEME - PROJECT SYNOPSIS" in the top left corner, should be sent by registered post to the address below at the latest by **17 November 2021**.
