Revised Tariff for Energy Export under CEB's Renewable Energy Schemes

The **Central Electricity Board (CEB)** is pleased to announce an upward revision of the tariff for energy exported to the grid under the following Renewable Energy (RE) Schemes:

- CEB Solar PV Scheme for Domestic Customers (Households)
- CEB Solar PV Scheme for Charging of Electric Vehicles
- CEB Solar PV Scheme for Corporate Entities' Electric Vehicles Charging
- CEB Scheme for Service Providers Charging of Electric Vehicles Service
- CEB RE Scheme for Non-Governmental Organisations and Charitable Institutions
- CEB Renewable Energy Scheme for Religious Bodies
- CEB Solar PV Scheme for Educational Institutions

Effective from **01 November 2023**, and until further notice, all energy units (kWh) exported to the grid under the above-mentioned Renewable Energy Schemes will be remunerated at the new tariff of **MUR 4.20 per kWh**. The new rate will only be applicable to **projects that have not yet been commissioned** as of this date.

It should be noted that the revised tariff has been aligned with the tariff applicable under the MSDG, Smart City, and Public Sector Entities Renewable Energy Schemes.
