REVISED TARIFFS FOR ENERGY EXPORTED UNDER CEB'S MSDG - SMART CITY/PUBLIC SECTOR ENTITIES SCHEMES

In line with the measures enunciated in the Budget Speech 2022-2023, the **Central Electricity Board (CEB)** wishes to inform its customers and the general public that the Tariff (T), also known as the Feed-In Tariff (FIT), which is applicable to CEB's Renewable Energy (RE) Schemes (MSDG - Smart City/Public Sector Entities Schemes) has been revised upwards.

In this regard, notice is hereby given that the revised rate for this Tariff has been fixed at MUR 4.20 per kWh. The new rate of MUR 4.20 per kWh will be applied to all units (kWh) of electricity exported to the CEB grid, under the above-mentioned Schemes, with effect from 12 December 2022.

The revised Tariff will be applicable only to projects with a capacity of up to two megawatts (2 MW) that have not yet been commissioned.

The revised rate includes a premium offered by the Government as an incentive to support the development and implementation of solar photovoltaic (PV) generation projects under these CEB Schemes. The premium rate will be valid for each relevant Connection Agreement (CA) or Energy Supply and Purchase Agreement (ESPA), provided that proof of order for all major project equipment is submitted no later than **31 May 2023** and implementation is completed by the deadlines set out in the individual CA or ESPA agreed.
