RENEWABLE ENERGY SCHEME 2024

Deployment of Cumulative 5 MW Solar Photovoltaic Systems on Public Buildings under the UNDP-Supported, GCF-Funded Project 'Accelerating the Transformational Shift to a Low Carbon Economy in the Republic of Mauritius'

Public Sector Entities (PSEs) are hereby invited by the **Central Electricity Board (CEB)** to apply for fully funded solar photovoltaic (PV) systems. This initiative aims to deploy a total of 5,000 kilowatts (5 megawatts) of solar PV systems on public buildings under the UNDP-Supported, Green Climate Fund (GCF)-Funded Project, 'Accelerating the Transformational Shift to a Low Carbon Economy in the Republic of Mauritius', which is being implemented by the CEB.

Out of the total allocated capacity, 500 kilowatts (kW) have been earmarked for Rodrigues Island.

The capital costs for the deployment of the solar PV installations will be fully funded by the Government (73%) and the GCF grant (27%). PSEs may also explore alternative financing proposals in consultation with the CEB.

Eligible PSEs, including statutory bodies, government-owned entities, and government-controlled entities in Mauritius and Rodrigues, are required to download the relevant application form from <https://ceb.mu/projects/pse2024>

The duly completed application form, along with all required documents, should be submitted by email to psegcf@ceb.mu or sent by registered post / delivered in person to the CEB Registry, Corporate Office, Ebène, at latest by 13 December 2024. Applications received in excess of the 5 megawatts allocated capacity will be placed on a waiting list.
