LAUNCHING OF PHASE 2 OF CEB MEDIUM-SCALE DISTRIBUTED GENERATION (MSDG) SCHEME

The Central Electricity Board (CEB) is pleased to inform its Customers of the Launching of Phase 2 of CEB Medium-Scale Distributed Generation (MSDG) Scheme, which operates under the principle of gross metering.

In this second phase of the Scheme, the CEB will integrate Renewable Energy (RE) projects from non-Domestic Customers into the grid for a total cumulative capacity of ten (10) megawatts (MW). Small-Scale Distributed Generation (SSDG) projects may also be considered under the Scheme. Projects received in excess of the allocated capacity will be placed on a waiting list.

All existing terms and conditions of the MSDG RE Scheme will remain unchanged.

All interested non-Domestic CEB Customers are invited to take cognisance of the terms and conditions of the Scheme and to fill in and submit the relevant Application Form at any CEB Customer Service Centre as from <u>03 April 2023</u>.
