LAUNCHING OF CEB RENEWABLE ENERGY (RE) SCHEME FOR RELIGIOUS BODIES

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

Within the framework of the Renewable Energy Roadmap 2030, the CEB is hereby inviting Religious Bodies to express their interest for the setting-up of small and medium-sized solar photovoltaic (PV) projects under the CEB Renewable Energy (RE) Scheme for Religious Bodies. Requests from Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs), including charitable organisations, may also be considered.

This initiative is in line with the national budget measure relating to the setting-up of new Renewable Energy Generation Schemes to promote the generation of electricity from solar photovoltaic sources by small and medium-scale power producers. The aim is to install solar PV installations **for a cumulated capacity of 4 MW**, which will eventually contribute towards meeting the national target of generating 35% of our electricity from renewable sources by 2025.

Under the Renewable Energy (RE) Scheme for Religious Bodies, the investment, operational and maintenance costs of the solar PV installations will be covered by the CEB. The terms and conditions, which include determining the size (capacity) of each solar PV installation, will be defined after completion of the EOI exercise and on-site surveys. The Scheme may be implemented in phases.

All interested Religious Bodies are invited to fill in and submit the required "CEB RENEWABLE ENERGY (RE) SCHEME FOR RELIGIOUS BODIES EOI FORM", which is available on CEB's website at https://ceb.mu. The duly-filled EOI Form, together with all requested documents, enclosed in a properly sealed and clearly-labelled envelope, should-be-sent-by-registered-post to the Strategic & Business Planning Executive, Central Electricity Board, CEB Corporate Office, Rue du Savoir, Cybercity, Ebène, Republic of Mauritius. The EOI Form can also be sent-by-electronic mail to the following address: rbrescheme@ceb.intnet.mu. The deadline for submission of the EOI Form is 31 January 2020.
