General Notice No. 1804 of 2022

THE UTILITY REGULATORY AUTHORITY

In the exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 6(1)(d) of the Utility Regulatory Authority Act, the Utility Regulatory Authority hereby fixes the prices, as specified hereunder, to be charged for the supply of electricity.

1. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the Supply to Residential Consumers during any particular month shall be in accordance with the Tariffs set out in Appendix I.
2. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the Supply to Commercial Consumers, to Commercial Prosumers and to Bulk Consumers during any particular month shall be in accordance with the Tariffs set out in Appendix II.
3. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the Supply to Industrial Consumers and Industrial Prosumers during any particular month shall be in accordance with the Tariffs set out in Appendix III.
4. The price that shall be charged by the Board during any particular month for the Supply to Sugar Factories requiring standby supply for starting the factory and emergency supply during the crop season shall be in accordance with the Tariffs set out in Appendix IV.
5. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the Supply to Municipal, District and Village Councils for street lighting purposes and traffic lights during any particular month shall be in accordance with the Tariff set out in Appendix V.
6. The price that shall be charged by the Board during any particular month for the Supply to an Industrial Consumer for pumping for irrigation purposes only shall be in accordance with the Tariff set out in Appendix VI.
7. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the Supply for temporary purposes shall be in accordance with the Tariff set out in Appendix VII.
8. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the Supply to a Residential Prosumer during any particular month shall be in accordance with Tariff set out in Appendix VIII.
9. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the Supply to Residential Consumers who have installed electric chargers solely for the purpose of charging electric cars shall be in accordance with the Tariff set out in Appendix IX.
10. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the Supply to a Bulk Consumer in the light rail industry shall be in accordance with the Tariff set out in Appendix X and shall be subject to revision in January of each calendar year.
11. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the Supply to Other Prosumers during any particular month shall be in accordance with Tariff set out in Appendix IV, V, VI, VII and X.
12. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the meter rental during any particular month shall be in accordance with Tariff set out in Appendix XI.
13. The Tariffs for the Commercial Prosumers, the Industrial Prosumers, the Residential Prosumers and the Other Prosumers shall not apply to Prosumers registered with the Board as distributed generators prior to August 2015.
14. All Bills shall be rounded to the nearest rupee.
15. The revised tariffs shall take effect as from 1 February 2023, except for Industrial Consumers and Industrial Prosumers the revised tariff will be implemented in 2 phases as set out in Appendix III.
16. For accounting purposes electricity bills issued in respect of consumption related to meter readings

taken on *1 February 2023 and until 28 February 2023* shall be calculated on a pro-rata basis. For the sake of this calculation, each day's consumption shall be deemed to be the equivalent of *1/28th* of the total consumption registered on the meter since the date of the last reading.

APPENDIX I
THE UTILITY REGULATORY AUTHORITY
TARIFF 110A, 110, 120 AND 140

TARIFFS 110A - Tariffs applicable to:

- (a) households receiving Government social allowance, under the Social Register of Mauritius from the Ministry of Social Integration, Social Security and National Solidarity and Senior Citizens Welfare & Reform Institutions;
- (b) socially-vulnerable households registered by the National Empowerment Foundation and/or National Social Inclusion Foundation;
- (c) CEB Residential Consumers (households only) registered under Tariffs 110 and 120, excluding SSDG owners, and having a minimum of 6 consecutive monthly consumptions subject to the following conditions:
 - (i) The average monthly consumption under the yearly assessment period shall not exceed 85 kWh.
 - (ii) The electricity consumption in any one month during the assessment period should not exceed 120 kWh.
 - (iii) The Customer's place of abode (residence) is occupied.

This condition is applicable to accounts only having a declared load above 300 watts. Residences having electricity account categorized under Tariff 120 with consumption of 15 kWh or less during each of the last 3 consecutive months are considered as unoccupied.

Eligibility to the Social Tariff 110A shall be reviewed on a calendar yearly basis.

A surcharge of Rs 105.00 per kVA, irrespective of application of minimum charge or not, shall be levied on the excess kVA recorded for the month or part thereof if the calculated average power factor for the month or part thereof is less than 0.90.

The average Power Factor for a month is calculated from the ratio:

$$\frac{\text{kWh recorded for the month or part thereof}}{\text{kVAh recorded for the month or part thereof}}$$

Excess kVA is calculated from the formula: $E = \frac{M \times (0.90 - P)}{0.90}$

Where E = Excess kVA

M = Maximum Demand in kVA recorded for the month or part thereof

P = Calculated Average power factor for the month or part thereof
