

CENTRAL ELECTRICITY BOARD

In the exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 20 of the Central Electricity Board Act, the Board hereby fixes the prices to be charged for the supply of electricity as follows :

1. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the supply of electricity to Domestic Consumers during any particular month shall be in accordance with the tariffs set out in Schedule I to this notice.
2. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the supply of electricity to Commercial and to Bulk Consumers during any particular month shall be in accordance with the tariffs set out in Schedule II to this notice.
3. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the supply of electricity to Industrial Consumers during any particular month shall be in accordance with the tariffs set out in Schedule III to this notice.
4. The price that shall be charged by the Board during any particular month for the supply of electricity to Sugar Factories requiring standby supply for starting the factory and emergency supply during the crop season shall be in accordance with the tariffs set out in Schedule IV to this notice.
5. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the supply of electricity to Municipal, District and Village Councils for street lighting purposes and traffic lights during any particular month shall be in accordance with the tariff set out in Schedule V to this notice.
6. The price that shall be charged by the Board during any particular month for the supply of electricity to an Industrial Consumer for pumping for irrigation purposes only shall be in accordance with the tariff set out in Schedule VI to this notice.
7. The price that shall be charged by the Board for the supply of electricity for temporary purposes shall be in accordance with the tariff set out in Schedule VII to this notice.
8. All bills shall be rounded to the nearest rupee.
9. The revised tariffs shall take effect as from *1 April 2008*.

For accounting purposes electricity bills issued in respect of consumption related to meter readings taken on *1 April 2008 and until 30 April 2008* shall be calculated on a pro-rata basis. For the sake of this calculation, each day's consumption shall be deemed to be the equivalent of *1/30th* of the total consumption registered on the meter since the date of the last reading.

Running Charge - Rs 5.49 per kWh

Minimum Charge - Rs 114.00 per month or part thereof per kilowatt or fraction thereof of total connected load, subject to a minimum of Rs 114.00 per month

TARIFF 250 - ***MAXIMUM DEMAND TARIFF FOR COMMERCIAL CONSUMERS POSSESSING AN INVESTMENT CERTIFICATE (ICT SCHEME) OR A BUSINESS REGISTRATION CARD (ICT) ISSUED UNDER SECTION 8(2) OF THE BUSINESS REGISTRATION ACT 2002.***

Demand Charge - Rs 160.00 per kVA of Maximum Demand, subject to a minimum of 20 kVA

Running Charge - Rs 3.18 per kWh

Minimum Charge - A sum equal to the highest Demand Charge paid in any one of the preceding six months of account

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POWER FACTOR CLAUSE (Applicable to Tariffs 217, 225, 250)

A surcharge of Rs 81.00 per kVA, irrespective of application of minimum charge or not, shall be levied on the excess kVA recorded for the month or part thereof if the calculated average power factor for the month or part thereof is less than 0.90.

The average Power Factor for a month is calculated from the ratio:

$$\frac{\text{kWh recorded for the month or part thereof}}{\text{kVAh recorded for the month or part thereof}}$$

Excess kVA is calculated from the formula: $E = \frac{M \times (0.90 - P)}{0.90}$

Where E = Excess kVA

Running Charge - Day Rate : Rs 2.53 per kWh

Night Rate : Rs 1.97 per kWh

Minimum Charge - A sum equal to the highest Demand Charge paid in any one of the preceding six months of account

Day Rate is applicable from 06.00 hrs to 18.00 hrs
Peak Rate is applicable from 18.00 hrs to 21.00 hrs
Night Rate is applicable from 21.00 hrs to 06.00 hrs

TARIFF 340 - MAXIMUM DEMAND TARIFF FOR INDUSTRIAL CONSUMERS POSSESSING A FREEPORT LICENCE AND SUPPLIED AT LOW VOLTAGE

Demand Charge - Rs 150.00 per kVA of Maximum Demand, subject to a minimum of 20 kVA.

Running Charge - Day Rate : Rs 3.67 per kWh
Night Rate : Rs 2.90 per kWh

Minimum Charge - A sum equal to the highest Demand Charge paid in any one of the preceding six months of account

Day Rate is applicable from 06.00 hrs to 20.30 hrs
Night Rate is applicable from 20.30 hrs to 06.00 hrs

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TARIFF 350 - MAXIMUM DEMAND TARIFF FOR INDUSTRIAL CONSUMERS POSSESSING A FREEPORT LICENCE AND SUPPLIED AT HIGH VOLTAGE TARIFF APPLICABLE TO CONSUMERS HAVING A TOTAL DECLARED LOAD EXCEEDING 500 kVA

Demand Charge - Rs 150.00 per kVA of Maximum Demand, subject to a minimum of 20 kVA.

Running Charge - Day Rate : Rs 3.48 per kWh
Night Rate : Rs 2.80 per kWh

Minimum Charge - A sum equal to the highest Demand Charge paid in any one of the preceding six months of account

Day Rate is applicable from 06.00 hrs to 20.30 hrs
Night Rate is applicable from 20.30 hrs to 06.00 hrs

POWER FACTOR CLAUSE (Applicable to Tariffs 313, 317, 320, 323, 325, 330, 340 & 350)

A surcharge of Rs 81.00 per kVA, irrespective of application of minimum charge or not, shall be levied on the excess kVA recorded for the month or part thereof if the calculated average power factor for the month or part thereof is less than 0.90.

The average Power Factor for a month is calculated from the ratio:

$$\frac{\text{Total kWh recorded for the month or part thereof}}{\text{Total kVAh recorded for the month or part thereof}}$$

Excess kVA is calculated from the formula: $E = \frac{M \times (0.90 - P)}{0.90}$

Where E = Excess kVA

P = Calculated average power factor for the month or part thereof

M = Maximum Demand in kVA recorded for the month or part thereof

A. TARIFF FOR STREET LIGHTING

Unmetered Flat Charge : Rs 7.11 per kWh, based on the number of hours of operation and the total wattage of lamps installed

Hours of Operation : Based on the sum of the hours of darkness in the current month between the daily times of sunset and sunrise as published by the Meteorological Department

For billing purposes the number of hours of darkness for each month shall be as follows:

Minimum Charge : Based on the wattage of lamps connected, or 25% of the amount paid during the month preceding a cyclone, whichever is the higher.

B. TARIFF FOR TRAFFIC LIGHTS

Unmetered Flat Charge : Rs 7.11 per kWh, based on 24 hours per day and the total wattage of the maximum number of lamps lighting at any time.

Minimum Charge : 25% of the amount paid during the month preceding a cyclone.

1. The Charge comprises

- (a) A flat rate of Rs 11.35 per kWh
- (b) A connection and disconnection charge of Rs 750.00

The consumption in kWh is calculated as follows:

Total connected load in kW x number of hours of use per day x number of days.

- 2. In cases where requests for Temporary Supply are received from applicants whose premises are not connected to the network, it will be for the applicant to provide the appropriate cable, Main Switch, and all mandatory protective equipment.
- 3. All charges calculated in accordance with Section 1 are to be paid in advance.
