The Central Electricity Board (CEB) is pleased to invite bids for the Construction of a new Building & Miscellaneous Works at Saint Louis Power Station from bidders having a valid registration with CIDB in Building Construction works in the grade that would allow them to perform the value of works for which they are submitting their bids as per requirements contained in the Bidding document. Participation is limited to citizens of Mauritius or entities incorporated in Mauritius. Joint Ventures should be among entities in Mauritius.

This procurement is being conducted through Open National Bidding procedures according to the Provisions of the Mauritius Public Procurement Act.

A pre-bid meeting is scheduled on Tuesday 28 January 2020 at 10 00hrs at CEB, Saint Louis Power Station, Plaine-Lauzun.

Bids in sealed envelopes clearly marked "CPB/80/2019: Construction of a new Building & Miscellaneous Works at Saint Louis Power Station", addressed to The Chief Executive, should either be deposited in the Tender box situated at the undermentioned address or sent by courier service or registered post so as to reach the Chief Executive on or before Wednesday 26 February 2020 up to 13 30hrs (local time) at latest.

Electronic bidding shall not be permitted. Late bids shall be rejected.
